

ORDINANCE NO. 294

AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE THE RIDING OF BICYCLES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF PAYETTE, IDAHO AND PROVIDING PUNISHMENT FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Payette, Idaho:

Section. 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to ride a bicycle on any side-walk or the parking between the side-walk and curbing within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, provided, however, that the mayor of the City of Payette, Idaho shall have the power at his discretion to issue permits in writing to any applicant. Provided, further, that said permit shall not give the holder thereof the right to ride a bicycle on any side-walk within the business section of the City of Payette, Idaho, *except in case of cripples and police officers while in the discharge of their duties.* Provided, further, that said permit shall be subject to revocation at any time with or without cause. Provided, further, that the holder of said permit shall carry the same with him and shall produce the same for inspection to any officer of the City of Payette, Idaho upon demand and that refusal to do so shall work an immediate revocation thereof. Provided further, that said permit may not in any way be construed as a defense in any action brought against the holder thereof for the violation of any ordinance or part of any ordinance of the City of Payette, Idaho.

Section 2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined on conviction thereof in a sum of not less than \$5.00 and not more than \$100.00.

Section 3. The fee for issuing permit shall be fifty cents each.
