

ORDINANCE NO. 53.

An ordinance amending Section 7 of ordinance No. 30 of the City of Payette, providing for raising revenues, and placing a license on theaters, menageries, public readings, shows, peddlers, hawkers and draymen.

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette:

Section 1. That Section 7 of Ordinance NO. 30, entitled "An ordinance providing for raising revenues, and placing a license on theaters, menageries, public readings, shows, peddlers, hawkers and draymen", be amended so as to read as follows:

Section 7. From each peddler, the sum of Ten Dollars per day, and any person or firm who shall ~~occasionally~~ ^{habitually} run a wagon for the purpose of peddling or selling meats, shall pay a license of Twenty-five Dollars for the period of three months. There are excepted from the provisions of this ordinance, farmers and persons peddling products of their own farms and gardens, and persons peddling fish, game or milk.
