

ORDINANCE NO.

74 by Wells

An Ordinance amending Section 1. of Ordinance No. 70 of the City of Payette entitled "An Ordinance concerning Saloons, Dramshops and places where intoxicating liquors are sold under license and providing that all screens, blinds or other obstructions to a view of the interior of such Saloon, dramshop or place shall be prohibited and providing penalties for a violation of this Ordinance".

Be it ordained by the Mayor and Council of the City of Payette; Idaho.

Section 1. That Section 1 of Ordinance No 70 of the City of Payette be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:-

" It shall be unlawful for the proprietor, keeper or other person maintaining keeping or conducting any Saloon Dramshop, or place where intoxicating, spirituous, vineous or malt liquors are sold under license within the corporate limits of the City of Payette, Idaho, to erect, construct, maintain or keep any blind, screen, painted window, stained glass or other screen, blind or obstruction which shall either obscure or prevent a view of the interior of such Saloon, dramshop or other place during any time when such Saloon, dramshop or other place is required by the ordinances of the City of Payette to be closed, or during any time when admission thereto is ~~permitted~~ *Prohibited*
