AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION (7) SEVEN OF ORDINANCE NO. 10 ENTITLED  
"AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE COMPENSATION OF THE OFFICERS OF THE CITY OF

Section I. That section seven (7) of ordinance No. 10 be, and the same is hereby repealed.

Section 6. Commencing at a ~~point~~ Section corner common to Sections 27 and 34, Township 9, North of Range 5, West of the Boise Meridian, thence East 1320 feet, thence North ~~to~~ 350 feet, thence West 1320 feet, thence South 350 feet to place of beginning, to be known as Whitney's Addition.

Section 7. Commencing at a point 1320 feet East of the Section corner common to Sections 27 and 34, in Township 9, North of Range 5, West of the Boise Meridian, thence East 1320 feet, thence South 300 feet, thence West 1320 feet, thence North 300 feet to place of beginning, to be known as McGlinchy's Addition.
